Situation

Ideally located at 1825 Collins Ave, Nautilus, a SIXTY Hotel, is a 250-room oceanfront property originally named the Nautilus Hotel. Originally designed in the 1950's by famed architect Morris Lapidus, the hotel stretches from Collins Avenue to the Beach.

Accommodation

Casual and elegant, the guest rooms of Nautilus South Beach are inspired by a residential European beach house infused with pieces which reflect a mid-century jet set style.

King Superior rooms offer one king bed in each room. They are designed with comfort in mind, starting from 285 sq. feet; with some that offer city views. The white marble floor with dark grey tone accent creates a contrast that is warm and inviting. Some rooms, facing Collins Avenue, have multi-sectional windows providing a unique floor to ceiling design. King Superior rooms offer standalone showers. Some rooms have balcony with ocean or pool view.

Restauration

The hotel's 200-seat signature restaurant, Driftwood Room, features both indoor and outdoor dining experiences marrying cuisine of Southern France with a Miami palate and locally sourced ingredients.

NAUTILUS CABANA CLUB

Escape to the Nautilus' expansive heated salt water pool and outdoor pool bar. Nautilus Cabana Club features eight lavish cabanas – each including a dining table, minibar and entertainment system. The playful backyard setting offers four nests for lounging and overlooks the beach, with private chairs for beach service. The Nautilus Cabana Club menu is available daily.

DRIFTWOOD ROOM

Designed with mid-century roots, the Driftwood Room, offers Mediterranean cuisine with fresh Floridian ingredients, a private dining room for 16 and an outdoor terrace spanning 1,950 square feet. Driftwood Room's menu features creative updates on simple dishes made with locally sourced ingredients, marrying the cuisine of Southern France with a Miami palate. Driftwood Room is open 7 days a week for breakfast, lunch and dinner.
